

History

The St. John Genealogy Project Website has been historically a free and publicly open site where visitors had access to current research and DNA results. To produce these results DNA testing and primary record research efforts are required. Both cost money. In the last few years, money to test several St. John surnamed men resulted in NPE results. Now, Big Y testing is the only reliable Y-DNA test to verify branches are related. In addition to regular costs to run this website, update information and research, a Big Y test kit costs \$449.00 USD per test kit. To upgrade kits to Big Y would cost upwards of \$50,000.00. This financial burden placed on the test subject is not necessarily fair since the results are shared publicly and benefit our entire project. Therefore, to offset these costs, a membership structure has been created to raise funds while also rewarding project participation.

- **GUEST (\$24.00 per month)** is for any visitor that does not contribute to this project in a significant way but wants access to its results.
- **BASIC (\$24.00 per year)** is for visitors who do several of the following as active participants in our project to the best of their abilities:
 - who have submitted their St. John lineage connecting them to the greater St. John family tree
 - who have DNA tested either a St. John descendant who has shared AncestryDNA, FamilyTreeDNA family finder, FamilyTreeDNA Y12-Y111 (St. John surnamed) results with the project, uploaded their DNA to Gedmatch, joined the Ancestor's Project at GedMatch, or any combination of DNA sharing that provides meaningful information to the project about the St. John family.
 - who participate in the St. John Genealogy and DNA Facebook Group
 - who help research and share their research with the project
- **EDITOR (\$12.00 per year)** is for persons trained in using TNG software who wish to help update the family tree by updating data, adding media, or building out branches.
- **BIG-Y (\$6.00 per year)** is for those St. John surnamed men (or their account administrators) who have taken the BIG-Y test at FamilyTreeDNA. This is not for Y12-111 test subjects unless they purchased individual SNP tests for DF27+ in which case they qualify too.
